Reading: This week starts IREAD. Students will be taking the IREAD test Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday mornings this week. We have been preparing rigorously for this test. We have been working on reading comprehension, antonyms, synonyms, homographs, prefix, suffix, multiple meaning words, etc. It is very important that students are present for these three days. If they are not, they will only have Thursday and Friday to make anything up. Anything that is not finished in that time frame will have to be made up over the summer. We also finished up *The Extra-Good Sunday* and will be starting our next story this week. Students will receive their new spelling words as well.

Math: We have finished up division and will take our test over chapter 7 on **Friday, March 18th**. We are already halfway into chapter 8 and will be starting on chapter 9, fractions, this week. Students will not have a test over chapter 8 seeing as it only covers more division problems.

Religion: We have completed our chapter on Lent and will be starting the next one on *Holy Week*.

Science: Our test over chapter 4 will be **Thursday, March 17th**. We will go over the study guides Monday, and students will be able to use them to study this week. These study guides serve as an excellent study component and I highly suggest the students review them, along with any other worksheets that have been completed.

English: we are continuing with interjections and possessive noun adjectives.
